Objective:

Obligations of the Parties

Responsibilities of IDEAL INSTITUTE OF PHARMACY and SWALIFE:

Both parties agree that, they shall provide the following to each other with mutual consent:

- Furnishing technical and process documentation for programs in member Institutes.
- Provide the facilities for carrying out academics/ teaching in the institutes viz. lecture hall, seminar hall, projector, computers etc. as required and availability in both institutes.

Execution and Operational Review:

- To manage the execution of this MoU, the parties agree to constitute an advisory committee consisting of two members each from both the parties. The advisory committee shall meet at least once in 3 months either at office of IDEAL INSTITUTE OF PHARMACY or SWALIFE.
- IDEAL INSTITUTE OF PHARMACY or SWALIFE will review the operations of the program twice a year. The purpose of the review shall be to assess the planning and operations of the program including, but not limited to its quality, timeline, performance and progress. The subject of expansion and amplification of the scope of this MoU will also be discussed during this meeting.

Exchange of Information and confidentiality:

The term "information" includes notes, presentations, academic documents, scientific or technical data, results and/or methods of investigation and other information intended to be provided, exchanged or arising under the areas of cooperation identified in the MoU. The parties shall take all measures to protect the secrecy of and avoid disclosure to any third parties and unauthorized use of the information which is confidential and outside the public domain. Individuals who will come into possession of privileged information shall be required to sign a **mutual non-disclosure agreement** to the above effect.

General Provisions:

- 1) The institution organizing an item of work shall have the nodal responsibility for mobilizing resources and the conduct of such works.

- 4) Neither party shall make a claim against the other party for any expenditure unless such expenditure has been agreed upon in writing between the parties.
- 5) The implementation of the areas and forms of cooperation identified in this MoU shall be subject to the availability and convenience of faculty, research-scholars, students and infrastructure facilities at the party's work place.
- 6) Any research publications and commercially exploitable innovations arising out of the joint research projects shall be jointly published or patented as appropriate.

Relationship of the Parties:

This MoU is not intended to create a relationship such as a partnership, joint venture, agency or employment relationship. Neither party may act in a manner that expresses or implies a relationship other than independent contractor nor bind the other party. Participation in this MoU shall not prevent either party from entering into similar MoUs with other institutions.

Assignment:


Neither party may assign or otherwise transfer any of its rights or obligations under this MoU, without the prior written consent of the other party.
