Donating blood is a simple thing to do; and to maintain an adequate blood supply, 1–3 percent of the population needs to become blood donors

Our college **Principal Dr. Sonali Uppalwar**, addressed the Importance of blood transfusions and to promote blood safety, Ideal hospital has for many years worked to support public to focus on four key areas: establishment of a nationally-coordinated blood transfusion service, collection of blood from exclusively voluntary donors from low-risk populations, testing of all blood for compatibility and transfusion-transmissible infections, and reduction of unnecessary transfusions.
